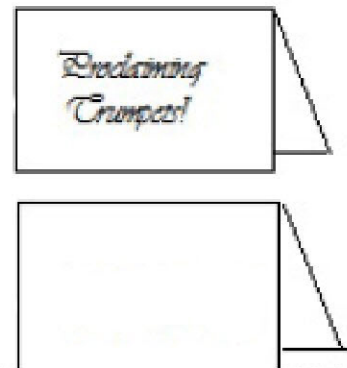
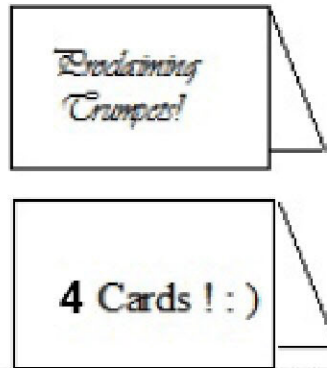
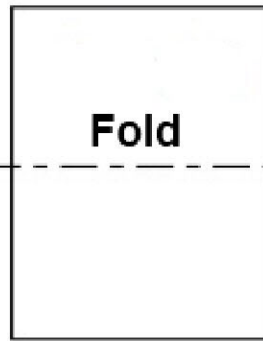

How to make full-over cards, approximately 4 inches by 2.25 inches.
1. Print double-sided onto paper or card stock.
2. Trim using the black lines as guides.
NOTE: First trim away the cut edges from the 8.5 x 11 inch sheet along printing it.
Then trim down the middle, trim between the two main cards.
